Work Environment

Position and Profile

We are looking for a legal advisor with spatial development experience who can analyze and advise on decisions on infrastructural projects with spatial consequences. In general, you can analyze the legal consequences of plans and advise on them. Part of that is presenting options, giving insight into consequences, conducting risk analyses, and bringing legal advice. Working with various stakeholders with sometimes conflicting interests is in good hands because you naturally seek solutions that bridge gaps. You advise on, among other things, decisions on enforcement, administrative measures, and permits. The Public Entity starts working on a spatial development plan, and you will be part of that process. Think of aspects concerning economic development and land/property challenges and help solve them. You work with the Land Registry (Kadaster) on Saba and the Netherlands.

Job Requirements

- You have a Master's degree in Dutch law, preferred in civil law (*privaatrecht*);
- You have at least 3 years of experience as a legal advisor in a relevant field with a solid track record;
- You have a complete theoretical understanding of the relevant policy area of spatial development and relevant related policy areas;
- You have litigation experience and experience in alternative ways of resolving disputes;
- You have insight into the functioning of the public administration, the government organization, and the related decision-making circuits and sensitivities;
- You are skilled in coordinating and drafting policy and advisory notes, procedural documents, legislative amendments, requests, plans, etc.;
- You are skilled in estimating the administrative relationships and the administrative/political and technical feasibility of advice or proposals;
- You have organizational and administrative qualities, and you have excellent communication and social skills;
- You like to work in a solution and result-oriented way;
- You can write and speak in English and preferably in Dutch as well.
