These include:</li> <li>the Well's Bay and up to the back of Troy Hill. The Ladder Bay area will be added at a later point in time.</li> <li>the areas of the Round Hill, Crispeen, Tara Ground, and part of the Bottom Mountain.</li> <li>the areas of the Johnny's Ground, the Flat of the Nut Trees, the Schooner Bush and Banana Gut.</li> <li>Hunting has been very successful over the past weeks. In June and July, a combined total of 460 goats was shot. Now that hunting is progressing, it is time to add more areas to the list of</li> </ul>
		intensified hunting.  Based upon input from the hunters and the people active in the reforestation project (including SCF), the following additional areas are proposed:  - Ladder Bay area and Paris Hill - Fort Bay and Landfill area
3		- Spring Bay and Kelby's Ridge It is advised to have a policy in place to give other hunters the possibility to continue hunting in their own areas, also if these are designated hunting areas. It is proposed to inform hunters (excluding the government and designated hunters) who want to hunt in the designated areas that hunting is allowed one day a week. The hunters need to inform the Public Entity at least 24 hrs in advance.
